The Project Workplan is mentioned in the RFA but there is not a link to upload or a template to download on the form. Will that be sent out?	Please make sure you are utilizing the right application. The Workplan is available for download under the attachments.
We will be transitioning during the grant period from a 44-bed facility to a new 60-bed facility. What amount would we be eligible for?	Applicants must submit a copy of their DHCS residential SUD facility licensure with funding application. An application can only be submitted for current licensed bed capacity.
Could this be used to start a mobile treatment program or is this for residential only?	This funding opportunity is only for residential treatment programs.
If you already provide MAT, what kind of expansion are you looking for in Track 2?	Any allowable expense/activities in Track 1, training and funding to cover updating prescriber knowledge, activities to increase the facility's number of prescribers/specialists – all with the overall goal of facilitating additional MAT inductions/maintaining those on MAT.
Can we subcontract with a MAT provider for onsite services?	Yes, you can subcontract for onsite services.
If our indirect rate is higher than 10%, can we provide the document for that and add the higher rate to the budget?	No, you cannot adjust the indirect rate.
Can this opportunity fund staffing, site improvements and other expenses for FBRS to establish MAT capacity at its DHCS-licensed outpatient facility?	This funding opportunity is available to residential facilities to provide MAT on site.
Is it relevant (i.e., would it need to be shown) that FBRS would use these improvements to deliver MAT to patients housed at nearby inpatient facilities (<i>i.e., it would be supporting clients receiving DHCS-licensed inpatient care, but they would receive care at the Outpatient facility</i>)?	This funding is intended for onsite MAT at the residential facility.
Is The Center able to discuss the timing, expected scope and expected grant size of the future Mobile MAT funding opportunity mentioned in the last webinar?	The Center is not able to release funding information before it is finalized.
If FBRS received funding from the current grant opportunity, would it be able to request funding from the future Mobile MAT opportunity to support additional mobile MAT capacity?	Organizations that receive funding for this opportunity would still be eligible to apply for other MAT funding, dependent on the RFA's eligibility requirements. Receiving funding does not make you ineligible for future funding opportunities.
